IEDA - THE PROJECT

Inclusive non-formal education for people with disabilities

IEDA is an Erasmus+ project that develops a **structured model** for integrating persons with disabilities into non-formal adult education, which serves as a basis for the implementation of future inclusive practices of non-formal education providers.

Our structured model is comprised of three project results :

- Curriculum for training on methods and approaches to teaching persons with disabilities in non-formal adult education.
- Curriculum for training on the application of assistive technologies in non-formal adult education.
- Comprehensive Handbook on the integration of persons with disabilities in non-formal adult education.

Our target groups are:

- Professionals and practitioners in the field of non-formal education and related fields.
- Providers of services for persons with disabilities.
- Persons with disabilities.



WHERE WE ARE NOW

After extensive research, partners are currently finalising the curricula and the handbook. Each to their own expertise, partners created materials that are useful to the trainers/providers of service to PWDs. As a partnership, it is of the utmost importance to us that the materials that we created are as accessible as possible also to PWDs, so continuously we involve them in the process of reviewing.

The partnership discussed the project progress in its last transnational meeting in Vienna, hosted by Orient Express.
